General Secretary's Report

At the start of 2020, no one could have predicted how the world would be impacted by COVID-

By March or April, BB Companies all over Asia were struggling as lockdown restrictions hit and BB activities cancelled. This challenging time presented a great opportunity to learn and grow together as BB family. All across Asia, countries and companies were exchanging ideas, learning to come together and trying new things, sharing experiences and lessons. We are encouraged to see how different countries came together to organize activities and programs. In the next few pages, you will read countries report, their struggles, joy and triumph over COVID-19. We also need to support BB countries that are still heavily affected by the pandemic. Physical meetings are still nor emcouraged in few countries as I penned this report.

Before COVID-19, live streaming of BB meetings were never heard off, but since the onset of the pandemic, live-streaming is the new norm for their BB companies meeting. BB companies around Asia are using live streaming services such as Facebook live, YouTube live, Zoom, Google+ and Periscope – not to mention the number of third party streaming services that allow for multiple platform simulcasting – to share words of encouragement to the online community.

BB Asia embraced the use of live streaming. After our EXCO physical meeting in Singapore in January 2020, we held all our EXCO meetings over zoom. BBA 13th and 14th General council meeting were conducted over zoom too. We thank God for the technology. With live streaming, we were able to meet even more regularly, and that too with negligible financial cost to BBA and member countries.

With current pandemic situation, We are forced to think out of the box to be creative with the new norm. Trainings and extension are run virtually. Mr William Wong report for a full coverage of the various extension and training activities carried out during the last one year.

INDIA

Nagaland

Nagaland is a mountainous state in the northeast India, bordering Myamar. Through pre-recorded video BBA Staff Mr. Ho Hee Mang and Ms. Melissa Amado introduced BB to the parents and the students of Life Foundation School, Nagaland, India during the chapel time in 11th of October, 2021. This is the school initial step in starting BB program.

Five teachers from Nagaland, India committed to serve God through BB ministry. The two BBA Staff conducted the online training weekly in July, 2021. The new officers are teachers from Life Foundation School in Nagaland. The school is a Christian school and the administration is keen to do BB program.



Vision / Mission / Plans

Flexibility in Training and Gatherings

When the pandemic first hit in 2020, we suspended all physical training and gatherings. After a year of hard work, the Headquarters have organised over 110 workshops, badge training courses for various Sections, virtual revival conference and evangelistic meetings, and had over 5,200 participants and view counts in total.

Developing Resources to Assist Companies

This year, we have applied for different fund resources to diversify our training services our Companies. We also held virtual workshops on arts, science, physical fitness, map reading, etc. A total of 600 Brigaders in man-time participated in this series.

Strategic Partnership; School Network

To pass on the BB ministry, we have established a network with schools through collaborating on programmes. It includes the community-based projects, the Child Development Fund (CDF), the Quality Education Fund (QEF), etc. This year, A total of 34 schools participated in the community-based project. In the coming academic year (2021-22), the number of partner schools will increase to 42.



5. 2021 Events Highlight

Due to Covid-19 and its measures, many of our events were hybrid – with either both a physical and online or purely online platform.

6. Events for 2022


